AMSTERDAM

The Hague: The third-largest city in the Netherlands and its only coastal city.

- > Mauritshuis Royal Picture Gallery: Home to Vermeer's famous painting "Girl with a Pearl Earring," Rembrandt's "The Anatomy Lesson" and "Self-portrait," among others. (Admission included)
- > Peace Palace: Home to the International Court of Justice. the Permanent Court of Arbitration, the Hague Academy of International Law, and the Peace Palace Library. Exterior

Utrecht: The hometown of "Miffy." The entire city is filled with Miffy characters, even the traffic lights, making it a charming place to stroll around.

- > Grand Place: A UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most beautiful squares in the world. Enjoy some free time to try Belgian waffles and chocolates.

BRUSSELS > LONDON

Take the Eurostar train to London.

London: The capital of the United Kingdom.

- > Big Ben: An iconic landmark in London. Exterior view.
- > Tower Bridge: One of London's famous buildings that opens in the middle to let ships pass through. Exterior
- > London Bridge: Located near Tower Bridge. Exterior view.
- > Buckingham Palace: The official residence and office of the British monarch. Exterior view.
- > Westminster Abbey: The site of coronation ceremonies for British monarchs. Exterior view.
- > Tower of London: Historically a fortress and royal palace. Exterior view.



DAY 6 Breakfast

LONDON > CAMBRIDGE > OXFORD

Cambridge: A world-renowned university city and technology

- > University of Cambridge: The third oldest university in the world, having educated scientists like Newton, Darwin, and
- > King's College: The most famous college in Cambridge, founded by King Henry VI, hence the name "King's College."
- > Corpus Clock: A unique golden clock unveiled by Stephen Hawking, known for its guirky time display.
- > Trinity College: One of the largest and most prestigious colleges in Cambridge, alma mater of Newton and Prince Charles. Exterior view.
- > Newton's Apple Tree: A popular photo spot.

Oxford: An ancient British city with a magical atmosphere.

> University of Oxford: The second oldest university in the world, having produced many Nobel laureates and British

prime ministers.

- > Christ Church College: Founded in 1546, it is the most aristocratic college in Oxford and a major filming location for Harry Potter. (Admission included)
- > Bodleian Library: One of the oldest libraries in Europe and a filming location for Harry Potter. Exterior view.



DAY 7 Breakfast

OXFORD > STONEHENGE > BATH

Stonehenge: Europe's most famous prehistoric monument, consisting of a circle of massive standing stones and lintels. (Admission included)

Bath: The only city in the UK designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, An ancient city in the southwest of England with unique rural scenery.

- > Royal Crescent: A series of Georgian-style buildings arranged in a sweeping crescent, very impressive.
- > Alexandra Park: A place to enjoy the stunning panoramic
- > Pulteney Bridge: An 18th-century bridge lined with shops on both sides, a great photo spot.
