DAY 2

BARCELONA

Barcelona: The second-largest city in Spain, a cultural city, and a tourist destination.

- > La Sagrada Familia: One of the world's iconic buildings and the only UNESCO World Heritage Site still under construction. (Admission included)
- > Columbus Monument: Built to commemorate the navigator Columbus who discovered the Americas.
- > Casa Batlló: Designed by Gaudi, known for its unique shapes, a classic work in architectural history. Exterior
- > La Pedrera Casa Mila: The last private residence designed by Gaudi. Exterior view.
- > Parc Guell: UNESCO World Heritage Site, designed by Gaudi, with a unique mosaic art style, one of the most important works of modernism worldwide. Exterior view.

BARCELONA > LA ROCA VILLAGE > VALENCIA

> Enjoy shopping with discounts of up to 30% - 60%.

Valencia: The third-largest city in Spain and the second-largest port, known as the "City of Sunshine" in Europe. The famous Spanish paella was born here.

- > Museu De Les Ciences: A particularly modern building, a landmark of Valencia. Exterior view.
- > Valencia Cathedral: Built in the 13th century, a landmark of the city. Exterior view.
- > Plaza de la Virgen: Built on the site of a Roman temple, with a central fountain believed to be the origin of Valencia.
- > Old Town: Full of local life, great for strolling and enjoying a famous Spanish paella meal.

VALENCIA > GRANADA

Granada: Known as the "City of Pomegranates," it was the last Moorish kingdom on the Iberian Peninsula.

- > Albayzin: A UNESCO World Heritage Site, the old town of Granada, characterized by its winding medieval Moorish
- Mirador de San Nicolas: A viewpoint with beautiful scenery, perfect for photos with the Alhambra Palace.

GRANADA > RONDA > SEVILLE

Ronda: Known as the "City of Romantic Getaways" by Hemingway. A white town on a cliff.

- > Puente Nuevo: The iconic landmark of Ronda, a spectacular stone bridge over the deep gorge connecting both sides of the city, a perfect blend of nature and human architecture.
- > Puente Viejo: Built in 1616, currently only accessible to pedestrians. The old bridge connects to the new bridge.

Seville: The fourth-largest city in Spain, the birthplace of Flamenco.

- > Plaza de Toros de Sevilla: One of the oldest bullrings in
- > Catedral de Sevilla: A UNESCO World Heritage Site and the largest Gothic cathedral in the world. Exterior view.
- > Plaza de España: The most famous and beautiful square in
- > Flamenco Show. Enjoy a Flamenco dance performance during dinner.




DAY 6 Breakfast

SEVILLE > LISBON

Lisbon: Known as the "City of Seven Hills," the capital of

- > Belem Tower: A UNESCO World Heritage Site with unique architectural style and special geographical location. Exterior view.
- > Jerónimos Monastery: A UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the Seven Wonders of Portugal. Exterior view.
- > Padrão dos Descobrimentos: A monument commemorating the Age of Discovery in the 16th century. Portuguese navigators embarked from here centuries ago. Exterior view.
- > Pastéis de Belém: Visit the world's first custard tart shop.
- > Avenida da Liberdade: The main street and bustling commercial street of Lisbon, with beautiful mosaic pavements, known as the Champs-Élysées of Portugal.



LISBON > CABO DA ROCA > PORTO

Cabo da Roca: The westernmost point of the European continent. "Here, the land ends and the sea begins."

Porto: The most romantic city in Portugal, one of the oldest cities in Europe, and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

- > Jardim do Morro: Overlooking the scenery on both sides of
- > Chapel of Souls: The church is adorned with 16,000 tiles on the exterior, intricate and unique.
- > Ribeira: The area along the Douro River from Ribeira Pier to Ribeira Square is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It is the most traditional neighbourhood in Porto.





PORTO > SALAMANCA

Salamanca: A UNESCO World Heritage Site known as the "Golden City".

- > University of Salamanca: Founded in the 13th century, one of the oldest universities in the world. Exterior view.
- > Plaza Mayor. Considered one of the most beautiful Baroque squares in Spain, enjoy local cuisine here.

SALAMANCA > SEGOVIA > MADRID

Segovia: A UNESCO World Heritage Site.

- > Aqueduct of Segovia: One of the most famous landmarks in Segovia, with over 2000 years of history.
- > Alcazar of Segovia: A 12th-century castle located at the highest point of the city, once the residence of the kings of Castile, and the inspiration for Disney's Snow White Castle.
- Enjoy a famous Spanish roast suckling pig lunch in

Madrid: The capital of Spain, one of the most vibrant cities in

- > Royal Palace: The official residence of the Spanish Royal Family, a grand Baroque-style building with luxurious interior decorations. Exterior view.
- > Puerta del Sol: One of the city's iconic landmarks.
- > Plaza Mayor. A historic square that is the centre of social life in the city, surrounded by traditional restaurants and cafes.
- > Mercado De San Miguel: A traditional Spanish market that gathers all Spanish delicacies.
