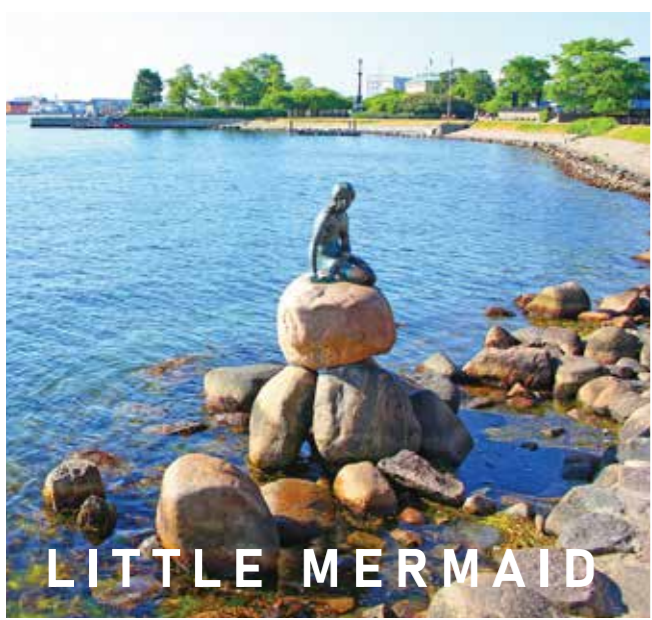




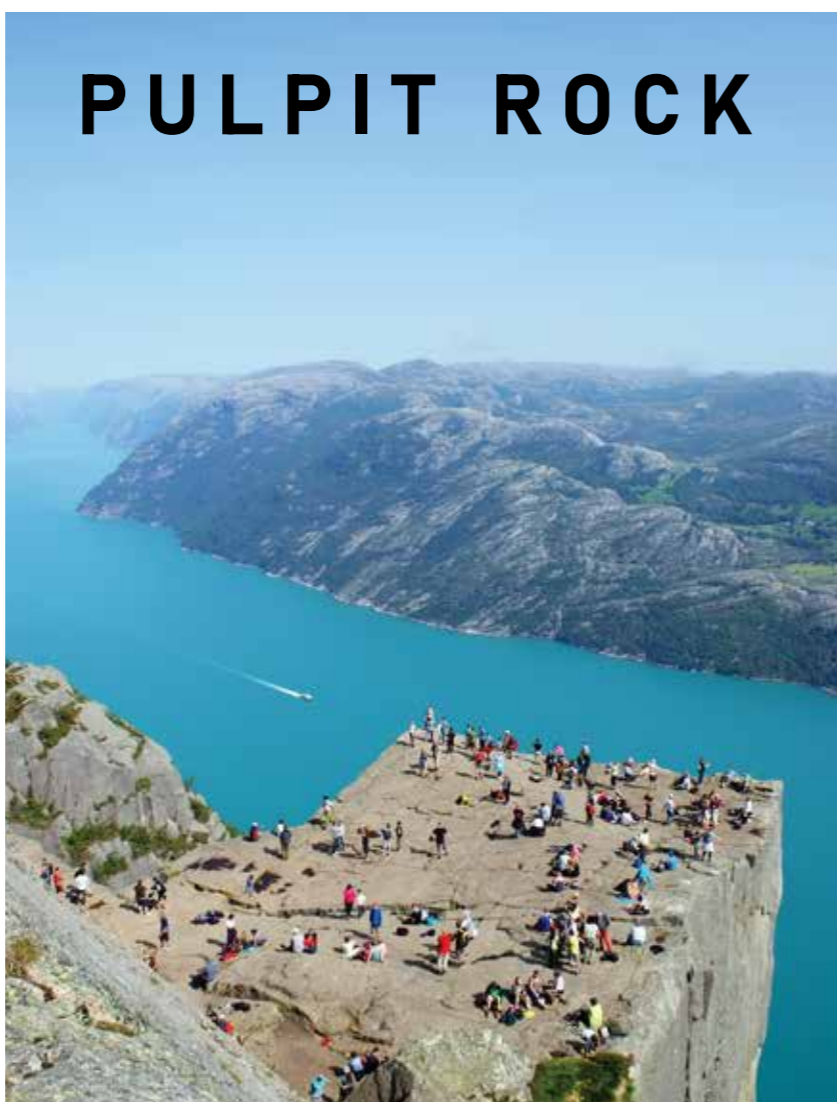

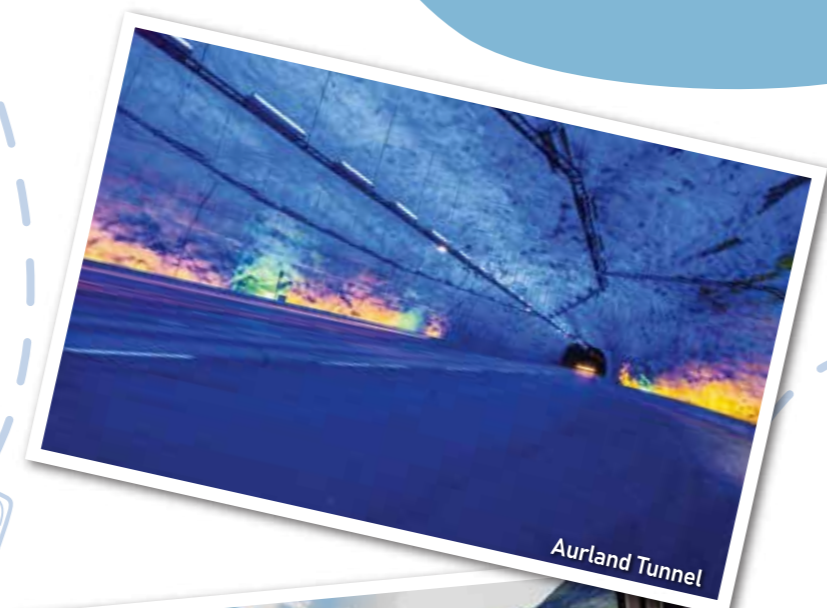

SINGAPORE ✈️ STOCKHOLM

Assemble at Changi Airport for your flight to **Stockholm, Sweden**.

DAY 2 Dinner
STOCKHOLM

- Stockholm city tour:**
- > **City Hall:** Stockholm's iconic landmark, home to the Nobel Prize banquet, known for its golden mosaics and grand architecture. (*In the occasion the main building of Stockholm City Hall is closed for conference, will only have a photo-stop of the exterior)
 - > **Cathedral & Royal Palace:** A symbol of Sweden's monarchy.
 - > **Old Town (Gamla Stan):** Stroll through charming cobblestone streets lined with colorful buildings and quaint cafes.

DAY 3 Breakfast + Dinner
STOCKHOLM - KARLSTAD - OSLO

- > **Karlstad:** Known for its sunny disposition and picturesque landscapes, is often referred to as "The City of Sunshine," offering a peaceful and scenic stop on your journey.
- > **Lake Vänern:** The largest lake in Sweden and the third-largest in Europe, is a natural wonder known for its crystal-clear waters and idyllic surroundings.
- > **Old Stonebridge (Östra Bron):** the longest stone bridge in Sweden.

DAY 4 Breakfast + Dinner
OSLO

- Oslo city tour:**
- > **Vigeland Sculpture Park:** An extraordinary open-air museum showcasing Gustav Vigeland's more than 200 lifelike and emotional sculptures.
 - > **Royal Palace & City Hall:** See the heart of Oslo's political and cultural life, with elegant architecture and rich history.
 - > **Karl Johans Gate:** Free time to stroll along Oslo's vibrant main street, lined with shops, cafes, and landmarks.
 - > **Akershus Fortress:** A medieval castle overlooking Oslofjord, offering insights into Norway's history and stunning views of the harbor.

DAY 5 Breakfast + Dinner
OSLO - AURLAND TUNNEL - VOSS

- > **Aurland Tunnel:** Experience the engineering marvel of the world's longest road tunnel, spanning 24.5 km.
- > **Stave Church:** An authentic wooden church dating back to the 12th century, a rare gem of medieval architecture. (Photo stop)

DAY 6 Breakfast + Dinner
VOSS - FLAM RAILWAY - SOGNEFJORD

- > **Flam Railway:** One of the world's most scenic train journeys, showcasing breathtaking waterfalls and dramatic mountain landscapes.
- > Continue to **Sognefjord** area (Sognefjord - a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the longest and deepest fjord in Norway).
- > **Nærøfjord Cruise:** Cruise through this UNESCO World Heritage Site, the narrowest fjord in the world.

DAY 7 Breakfast + Dinner
SOGNEFJORD - HARDANGERFJORD - BERGEN

- Move on to the Hardangerfjord region.**
- > **Hardangerfjord:** Known as the "Queen of the Fjords," the second-longest fjord in Norway. Its stunning landscapes include dramatic cliffs, sparkling waters, and lush orchards, making it one of the most picturesque regions in the country.
 - > **Steinsdalsfossen:** A unique waterfall near the village of Norheimsund, is famous for its walking path that allows visitors to stroll behind the cascading water without getting wet. (Photo stop)

DAY 8 Breakfast + Dinner
BERGEN - STAVANGER

- Bergen city tour:**
- > **Bryggen Wharf:** A UNESCO-listed medieval harbor with colorful wooden buildings, a vivid glimpse into Bergen's maritime history. Walk through the open-air **Fish Market**.
 - > **Floibanen Funicular:** Ride to Mount Fløyen for panoramic views of Bergen and its stunning fjord surroundings.
 - > Travel along scenic routes, crossing **Bjørnafjorden** and **Boknafjord**, as you make your way to Stavanger.

DAY 9 Breakfast + Dinner
STAVANGER - LYSEFJORD CRUISE - PULPIT ROCK - STAVANGER

- > **Lysefjord Cruise:** Sail through crystal-clear waters surrounded by steep cliffs and dramatic peaks.
- > **Pulpit Rock:** A natural marvel rising 604 meters above the Lysefjord, made famous by Mission: Impossible and offering breathtaking views.

DAY 10 Breakfast + Dinner
STAVANGER - OVERNIGHT CRUISE

- Stavanger city tour:**
- > **Stavanger Cathedral:** The oldest cathedral in Norway, built in the 12th century. (Photo stop)
 - > **Valberg Tower:** A historic watchtower built in 1853, offering panoramic views of Stavanger. (Photo stop)
 - > **Old Stavanger:** Wander through Europe's best-preserved wooden houses, painted in charming pastel hues.
 - > **Øvre Holmegate:** Known as "the street of colors," it's a vibrant hub for art, culture, and shopping.
 - > **Old town:** Enjoy some free time for shopping.
 - > Afterward, have an early dinner before boarding your **overnight cruise** to Denmark.

DAY 11 Breakfast + Dinner
HIRSTHALS - COPENHAGEN

- Arrive Hirtshals, continue to Copenhagen city tour:**
- > **Tivoli Gardens:** One of the world's oldest amusement parks, filled with charm, fun rides, and lush gardens.
 - > **City Hall Square:** A grand public square in the heart of Copenhagen.
 - > **Hans Christian Andersen's Statue:** A tribute to Denmark's beloved fairy tale author.
 - > **Christiansborg Castle:** Located on the island of Slotsholmen, this palace houses the Danish Parliament and the Prime Minister's Office.
 - > **The Little Mermaid Statue:** Copenhagen's iconic landmark inspired by Hans Christian Andersen's beloved fairy tale.
 - > **Gefion Fountain:** known for its stunning sculptures and large water features, making it a popular stop for photos.
